Performance Test Dates and Application Deadlines

PLEASE NOTE
**The discontinued RID
Generalist Written Test
is the ONLY test that
was replaced by the new
NIC Knowledge
(written) Test in 2004.**
As it stands, those who
took and passed the
Generalist Written Test

within the past five
years, and are currently
candidates for
certification, still have
the remainder of their
five-year cycle to take
and pass a performance
test.
ALL other written and
performance tests (OTC,
SC:L and CDI) will
continue to be
administered as usual.

In 2005, the NIC
Interview and
Performance Test
debuted. All who take
and pass the NIC
Knowledge Test will go
on to take the NIC
Interview and
Performance exam in
order to gain
certification. Those
whose RID Generalist
Written Tests are still
within the five years are
candidates for
certification will not be
required to take the NIC
Knowledge Test in order
to take the NIC
Interview and
Performance Test.

CDI Written Test - ASL Version and CDI Performance Test

Once you have applied
for either of these tests
and received your
receipt letter, you may
then schedule an
individual testing date at
any supersite that offers
that test.

Those applying for the
CDI Written Test are
encouraged to schedule
and take the ASL
Version since only this
version has much more
flexible test scheduling
and includes a copy of
the English Version as a
reference. This means
that you may refer to
either, or both, versions

of the test questions
while taking the CDI
Written Test – ASL
Version.
