Share-Shop Series

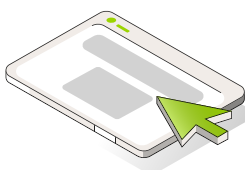
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WHAT:

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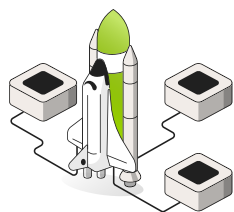


HOW:
